

WILDFLOWER SEED BALL INSTRUCTIONS

SUPPLIES

- Foil pan or baking pan with sides
- 12 oz. volume Kitty Litter (most basic, no scent, additives)
- 3 oz. volume Potting Soil
- Native Wildflower Seeds (1/4 oz.)
- 10 Mini paper cups (3 oz.)
- Small squirt bottle of water

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Combine 4 paper cups of kitty litter with 1 paper cup of potting soil in the foil pan.
2. Add seeds and mix. Starting with small amounts of water, gradually add water and work with hands to make a clay/play-do like dough.
3. Mold mix into 10 golf ball size balls. Place each seed ball into a paper cup for drying. Allow to dry at least 24-48 hrs.
4. The seed bombs may be placed on soil in your garden or we prefer throwing them. The seed bomb will break down over time releasing the seeds which will germinate and establish into plants. Although you can hurl your seed bombs anytime, we think that fall is best.
